- 2. Bid Opening Location: WV Division of Natural Resources, Property and Procurement Office, 324 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, South Charleston, WV 25303.
- 3. For clarification The final configuration of the re-graded 100-yard backstop must be covered with a minimum of 18-inches of debris-free material. However, this material is only required to be placed on the bottom 25-feet of the re-graded slope. It will extend the full length horizontally, and a minimum of 25-feet vertically.
- 4. The original project documents indicate that the contractor will install a driveway culvert, provided by the WVDNR. Per this addendum, the contractor will furnish and install the culvert. It will not be provided by the WVDNR. The culvert will be a corrugated metal pipe, 40-ft in length x 15-inches in diameter, and backfilled/compacted with ½-inch crusher run stone.
- 5. Debris-free material, for project purposes, is defined as being free of rocks larger than 1-inch in diameter, and free of woody, herbaceous material.
- 6. The walkways will be constructed with a 4-inch layer of ½-inch crusher run stone.
- 7. A copy of the pre-bid sign-in sheet is included with this addendum.

- 5. VERBAL COMMUNICATION: Any verbal communication between the Vendor and any State personnel is not binding, including verbal communication at the mandatory pre-bid conference. Only information issued in writing and added to the Solicitation by an official written addendum by the Property and Procurement Office is binding.
- 6. Va. Code § 21-11-11 requires any prospective Vendor to include the contractor's license number on its bid. If an apparent low bidder fails to submit a license number in accordance with this section, the Property and Procurement Office will promptly request by telephone and electronic mail that the low bidder and the second low bidder provide the license number within one business day of the request. - 1. PLAN AND DRAWING DISTRIBUTION: All plans and drawings must be completed and available for distribution at least five business days prior to a scheduled pre-bid meeting for the construction or other work related to the plans and drawings.
- 2. PROJECT ADDENDA REQUIREMENTS: The Architect/Engineer and/or Agency shall be required to abide by the following schedule in issuing construction project addenda. The Architect/Engineer shall prepare any addendum materials for which it is responsible, and a list of all vendors that have obtained drawings and specifications for the project. The Architect/Engineer shall then send a copy of the addendum materials and the list of vendors to the State Agency for which the contract is issued to allow the Agency to make any necessary modifications. The addendum and list shall then be forwarded to the Property and Procurement Office buyer by the Agency section. #### **GENERAL CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS**

- 1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE: The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is soliciting bids to establish a contract for shooting range improvements, including excavation, placement of excavated material, pipe installation, construction of earthen berms and walkway, minor grading, and seeding and mulching area of distrubed areas.
- 2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions and in the Specification's Manual as defined below.
  - 2.1 "Construction Services" means:

Excavating and grading the 100-yard hillside backstop area to a 1.5:1 slope, constructing a diversion ditch, placing excavated material as directed and as shown on plan sheets, removing trees/stumps, removing an existing culvert; installing new culverts, placing/compacting/grading fill areas; constructing earthen berms and backstops and walkway; minor grading to prevent ponding, seeding and mulching of disturbed areas. All work must be in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations; must utilize best management practices for erosion and sediment control. Work will include all incidental labor and materials, as more fully described in these specifications and the Specifications/Project Manual.

- 2.2 "Pricing Page" means the pages attached hereto, or included in the Specifications/Project Manual upon which Vendor should list its proposed price for the Construction Services.
- 2.3 "Solicitation" means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with Construction Services that is published by the Purchasing Division.
- 2.4 "Specifications/Project Manual" means the American Institute of Architect forms, specifications, plans, drawings, and related documents developed by the architect, engineer, or Agency that provide detailed instructions on how the Construction Services are to be performed along with any American Institute of Architects documents ("AIA documents") attached thereto.
- 3. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE: This General Construction Specifications document will have priority over, and supersede, anything contained in the Specifications/Project Manual.
- 4. QUALIFICATIONS: Vendor, or Vendor's staff if requirements are inherently limited to individuals rather than corporate entities, shall have the following minimum qualifications:

- 4.1. Experience: Vendor, or Vendor's supervisory staff assigned to this project, must have successfully completed at least 1 project that involved work similar to that described in the Specifications/Project Manual. Compliance with this experience requirement will be determined prior to contract award by the State through references provided by the Vendor upon request, through knowledge or documentation of the Vendor's past projects, through confirmation of experience requirements from the architect assisting the State in this project, or some other method that the State determines to be acceptable. Vendor must provide any documentation requested by the State to assist in confirmation of compliance with this provision. References, documentation, or other information to confirm compliance with this experience requirement may be requested after bid opening and prior to contract award.
- 5. CONTRACT AWARD: The Contract is intended to provide Agency with a purchase price for the Construction Services. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest qualified responsible bidder meeting the required specifications. If the Pricing Pages contain alternates/add-ons, the Contract will be awarded based on the grand total of the base bid and any alternates/add-ons selected.
- 6. SELECTION OF ALTERNATES: If the Pricing Pages contain alternates/add-ons, the alternates/add-ons will be selected as follows. The alternate/add-on will be selected in the order of priority listed on the Pricing Pages. The first alternate/add-on must be selected before the second alternate/add-on can be selected and so on.
