Vendor Question No. 1: Toilets Being Replaced? If so, please provide a model number to use

Agency Response: Toilets will be Owner supplied and installed.

<u>Vendor Question No. 2:</u> Shower faucet is a two handle not pressure balanced. Could be a code issue. Alternate?

Agency Response: Two handle faucets have been specified in shower stalls not being replaced, as the existing faucets in these stalls are two-handle.

<u>Vendor Question No. 3:</u> Kitchen model declares article stainless, but the note say agency to pick, please clarify.

Agency Response: Kitchen appliances must be stainless.

Vendor Question No. 4: Please reference Alternate #2 – Rewire Cabin to Hide Wiring in All Legacy Cabins. Can you please provide more direction/details for how this is to be accomplished? Is the existing panel to be relocated so that it can be recessed into the wall? If the panel is not recessed into a wall then the wiring cannot me hidden. Additionally, for the ceiling fixtures and power to the fixtures, there seems to be no way to provide power to these fixtures without the wiring being visible from all views.

Agency Response: Existing panel does not need to be relocated or recessed. Any exposed wiring that cannot be hidden, must be covered with molding that matches existing logs, or the wiring hidden by removal of the chinking between the logs, placing the wiring, and installing new chinking.

<u>Vendor Question No. 5:</u> Please reference Alternate #3 – Remove and Replace All Direct Wire Interior Light Fixtures. Can you please provide model/part #'s for the required lighting fixtures to be provided? The scope lists a series of light fixtures that have different models with a wide price range;

1. CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: W. Va. Code § 21-11-2 requires that all persons desiring to perform contracting work in this state be licensed. The West Virginia Contractors Licensing Board is empowered to issue the contractor's license. Applications for a contractor's license may be made by contacting the West Virginia Division of Labor. W. Va. Code § 21-11-11 requires any prospective Vendor to include the contractor's license number on its bid. If an apparent low bidder fails to submit a license number in accordance with this section, the Property and Procurement Office will promptly request by telephone and electronic mail that the low bidder and the second low bidder provide the license number within one business day of the request. Failure of the bidder to provide the license number within one business day of receiving the request shall result in disqualification of the bid. 

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

ALL CONTRACTS: Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Employer default" means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

AFFIRMATION: By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.


