2. RF-Works Proposed Services

2.1. Background

RF-Works is providing a response to the request for quotation based on the Division of Natural Resources, Tygart Lake State Park Wi-Fi Service DNR2000000016 which is seeking services of an engineering firm to provide contract services to manage and distribute the existing internet services based on the mandatory contract service requirements. The Public and Guest Wi-Fi connectivity services provided by RF-Works will identify a design on how the Wi-Fi Services will be distributed in the most efficient and cost-effective manner throughout Tygart Lake State Park, primarily focusing on the lodge (guest rooms, meeting areas, restaurant, and outside dock), marina (including dock slips and mooring buoys), beach area (including outdoor areas within the beach and bathhouse), park office, pavilion beside the park office, 11 cabins and cabin yards, outdoor campfire and playground areas, camping host office, and RV camping area.

2.2. Methodology, Qualifications and Experience

RF-Works Design Methodology -

RF-Works will performs active comprehensive, site evaluation and survey for an IEEE 802.11a/b/g/n/ac wireless local area network (WLAN) for indoor, outdoor, bridging, or meshed networks. The purpose of the evaluation is to ascertain the number and strategic placement of the access points (APs) required for seamless IEEE 802.11a/b/g/n/ac wireless radiofrequency (RF) propagation within the prescribed areas of the Tygart Lake State Park. The proposed WLAN Site Survey will deliver optimal bandwidth, wireless coverage, effective throughput, network capacity, roaming capability, ongoing management, and Quality of Service. The RF-Works engineering team will utilized RF testing equipment to test based on the service tier chosen by the IT Management to provide a design that provides a minimum of 20% overlap of adjacent cell coverage, where coverage is provided. A minimum signal floor of -70 dBm, with a minimum signal-to-noise ratio (SNR) of 25 dB for 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz spectra will observed within the extents of each cell. An active post installation certification is executed to provide coverage heat maps and to ensure the implementation was installed at designed.

2.3. Mandatory Project Requirements

Public Wi-Fi Connectivity -

RF-Works will provide a public Wi-Fi connectivity in the areas defined by WVDNR for Tygart Lake State Park. The System will provide a splash page with an acceptable use policy. RF-Works will provide the hardware necessary to provide Wi-Fi Service in all areas of connectivity. RF-Works will provide management of all activities of the hardware and will repair or replace any malfunctioning hardware at no extra charge to the State of West Virginia during the life of the contract.

RF-Works will monitor the networks health twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week. RF-Works will provide a help desk number for guest support and will offer a minimum four (4) hour response time, Monday through Friday, 7:00AM to 7:00PM EST.

RF-Works understands that the only Internet Connection available is located at the Lodge and the fiber link is provided by CityNet. It is also RF-Works understanding that the fiber will be made available and will be terminated and fiber will be available at the beach 911 pole, beach bath house. Park office, cabin 11, and Cabin 10. RF-Works will be responsible for providing hardware and replacing all other hardware necessary to effectively implement and manage the solution. The State of West Virginia Division of Natural Resources will not be responsible to provide any other hardware for the solution.

Red lines indicate the existing the existing terminated Fiber. Blue Line indicates the area that RF-Works will install the customer provided Overhead Fiber from the existing pole termination to the old nature building. The Green line indicates where RF-Works will provide and install a high-speed Wireless Bridge from the Lodge to the existing power Pole at the beach area. The yellow lines indicated the areas that RF-Works will provide and install WF-FI coverage. Public Wi-Fi Connectivity Areas are indicated below:

RF-Works understands that the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources may desire to provide internet service to the areas for a fee, such as the marina or beach area, while providing the other areas the service at no charge, such as the lodge or cabins. The system provided by RF-Works will be scalable to allow for a pay per use model in one or more areas of coverage. RF-Works payment portal will directly place funds in an account defined by the State of West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR). The WVDNR will be responsible for paying all processing fees associated with the account. The pay per use model provided by RF-Works will comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

RF-Works help desk will be able to assist customers in configuring their devices that support captive portal. RF-Works help desk will maintain an issue and resolution log that will be made available to the WVDNR every quarter, or as requested.
